Proposal

I move that Rules and Regulations paragraph 7.D.2 be amended by adding subpara a:
"In order for show results to be published in MEMO, both the class placings to include the size of each class, as well as the champion photos if usable, must be submitted to the Editor."

Reasons

In order for the reader, when perusing the published show results, to gain a perspective as to the nature of the competition and the importance of the championships won, all of the information relative to the size of the classes should be available. NPGA furnishes a template on which to enter the information which should appear in MEMO.

Since MEMO is a magazine which belongs to all dues-paying members, and show results are published at our expense, it is entirely reasonable for us to set the editorial parameters on which submissions are published. This new requirement simply directs that all show results published present **all** the information relative to the show and keeps everything in the proper perspective.

Advantages

Partial submissions deny the magazine reader the ability to put show winners in any type of perspective.

Disadvantages

Although it may result in an increased workload for a few shows, the far majority of show submissions already contain all of the information this amendment would now require.
