

## **AGENDA ITEM SUBMISSION FORM**

### ***Proposal***

I move that:

we repeal the June 2008 Board decisions to: 1. add one new color to the list of colors for agoutis both on the Registration Application and the Color Chart, to be identified as Grey/Brown Agouti to be defined as black and white hairs intermingled, producing an appearance ranging from highly grizzled to nearly solid or brown hairs mingled with white and black hairs, and 2. reinstate the original Breed Standard Committee report as submitted.

### ***Reasons***

As per the discussions resulting from the Color Workshop in January 2009, factual data was presented that showed that it is genetically impossible for black, brown and white hairs to coexist on a single Pygmy Goat, therefore the existence of a Grey/Brown Agouti Pygmy Goat is not possible.

### ***Advantages***

Clarifies and appropriately defines agouti colors.

### ***Disadvantage***

May result in some Pygmy Goats requiring re-registration with appropriate color designation.

### ***Financial Impact***

Minimal for re-registration.
